

Basic Guitar Setup and Repair

In this hands-on clinic, held in your classroom, students learn about some basic set and repair for their electric or acoustic guitar including: action, pickup height, hardware, string height, checking for neck straightness (not adjusting the neck), changing strings, tuners, cleaning, etc. NOTE: this clinic does not replace a professional guitar technician.

How much is the visit?

The visit is free. Donations are helpful but not at all expected.

How long is the visit?

The visit is 45-70 minutes depending on your schedule

How does the clinic work?

Each area is covered with students able to test/check their own instrument (materials will be loaned during class). Handouts are given to each student

What will the students learn?

Basic set and repair for their instrument (electric or acoustic) including: action, pickup height, hardware, string height, checking for neck straightness (not adjusting the neck), types of strings, changing strings, tuners, cleaning. Also included are a description of common tools and materials, suggestions for storing instrument, seasonal changes, guitar parts and how they function.
